Testimony of GDC Commissioner Nominee Amy Rosen Before the NJ Senate Judiciary Committee December 19, 2022

Good morning, Mr. Chairman; I am honored to appear before you today. I would like to take this opportunity to thank Governor Murphy for nominating me to oversee New Jersey's interest in the Gateway Program as a Commissioner of the Gateway Development Commission. In my various roles, dating way back to my term as a Deputy Commissioner of NJ Department of Transportation, I have had many opportunities to work on large public construction projects as well as having worked often with Kris Kolluri, the CEO of the Gateway Development Commission. I am confident that we will have a productive relationship and together make certain this project is completed as fast as possible.

Mr. Chairman, if this Committee votes to confirm my appointment, I will be a constructive and active member of the Commission, committed to safeguarding our state's interest in the timely and successful completion of the Gateway Program.
