




Tips for success in achieving and exceeding DBE goals:


- Engage early and negotiate prior to proposals being due.
- Provide **substantive and meaningful opportunities** across the full spectrum of the project and all its phases (design and construction), categories of work, and contracting tiers.
- **Develop contracting package plan commensurate with** capacity of the preponderance of the available pool.
- Establish transparent processes for qualifying and selecting firms.
- Conduct business affairs with DBE partners in accordance with our Vendor Code of Ethics and USDOT DBE regulations (i.e., prompt payment protocols).



















Work Included in the Contract

Major and Supporting work activities in this contact will include but are not limited to:

- Coordinate with the P4 Contractor for the Tonnelle Avenue Overhead Bridge, for joint use of the Tonnelle Avenue work sites
- Design, furnish and install construction staging laydown areas.
- Perform Pre-Construction Condition Surveys and prepare CIARs of facilities.
- Construct the open-cut and tunnel portal with related SOE at the Tonnelle Avenue Work site.
- Construct the construction access road to the Hoboken Shaft.
- Construct the Hoboken Shaft; slurry walls, rock excavation and support, and rock mass grouting.
- Design, coordinate and arrange for temporary construction power for TBMs, ancillary facilities, construction ventilation, lighting, and pumping at each construction site.

Work Included in the Contract

Major and Supporting work activities in this contact will include but are not limited to:

- Design, furnish, install, test, commission, operate, and maintain temporary systems, including the following:
- Temporary construction power systems.
- Temporary tunnel ventilation systems.
- Temporary tunnel drainage systems.
- Temporary water supply systems.
- Temporary lighting systems.
- Temporary compressed air systems.
- Temporary communications systems.
- Construct two bored tunnels using two hard rock TBMs mining in rock from the tunnel portal at Tonnelle Avenue site and mine easterly to the Hoboken Shaft.
- Furnish and install a precast concrete tunnel lining within those tunnels.

Work Included in the Contract

Major and Supporting work activities in this contact will include but are not limited to:

- Construct six cross passages in rock, including temporary and permanent support of rock. Furnish and install a waterproofing membrane system at each cross passage and a cast-in-place concrete tunnel lining.
- Transport excavated tunnel material from the Palisades Tunnel through the bored tunnels to the Tonnelle Avenue construction site.
- Furnish, install, maintain, protect, and interpret all geotechnical instrumentation.
- Design, furnish and install the necessary works and measures to ensure appropriate environmental compliance, construction dust, noise and vibration control, and mitigation of detrimental effects.
- Design, furnish, install, and maintain site security fences and temporary noise barriers.
- Perform inspection and testing services in conjunction with construction quality acceptance activities for all elements of the Work.
- Complete construction by Spring 2027.
