

## CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

**WHAT:** Construction of Noise Barrier Foundations

**WHERE:** Along the south side of W 18<sup>th</sup> Street

**WHEN:** April 16, 2025 – June 16, 2025  
7:00 AM to 3:30 PM (Weekdays)

Beginning April 16, Schiavone Lane Dragados JV (SLDJV) will start construction of the noise barrier foundations along the south side of W 18<sup>th</sup> Street.

To maintain and protect traffic, SLDJV will install a temporary construction barrier approximately 1.5 feet off the southern curb into the road (see detail on opposite page). The barrier, which will remain in place until September 2025, will be topped with a 6' chain-link fence and sound blankets to mitigate construction noise. The contractor does not anticipate any impact to the flow of traffic or parking while the barrier is in place.

The noise barrier foundations will be excavated using two drill rigs. All work will be performed within the limits of the work site. During drilling operations, noise exceedances could occur; however, SLDJV will take proactive measures to mitigate this as much as possible.

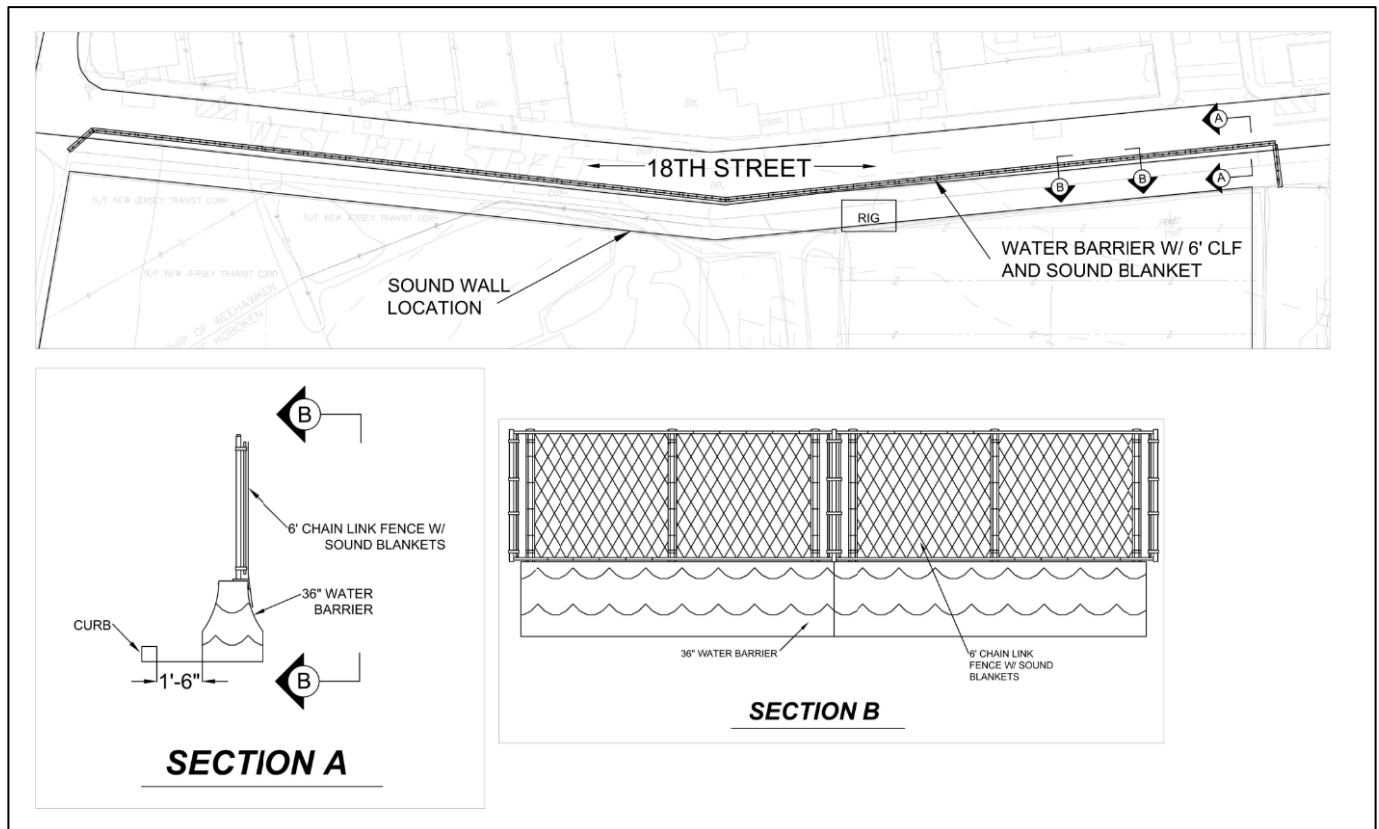


*When complete later this summer, the 25-foot-high aluminum wall will dampen the construction noise from the Hudson Shaft site to the Shades neighborhood.*

General Project Overview – The Palisades Tunnel Project will use tunnel boring machines (TBMs) to excavate two parallel tunnels—measuring approximately 5,100 feet long with an inside diameter of 25 feet—through the rock formations of the Palisades. The project also involves building the new Hudson County Shaft, which will be used to remove the TBMs when digging is complete. The project contractor is Schiavone Dragados Lane Joint Venture (SLDJV).
