
Boater Safety Alert

Starting on or about July 21, 2025, Weeks Marine will begin pile pulling in the footprints of former piers 68 and 69. All vessels are encouraged to navigate the area with caution and use the western side of the navigable channel.



The Hudson River Ground Stabilization (HRGS) project will fortify a section of the riverbed to enable tunnel boring machine operations for the future Hudson River Tunnel.

Starting on or about July 21st, 2025, the Weeks 573 barge will be on the east side of the channel to remove a timber pile field from the remnants of Pier 68 and 69. The Weeks 61 and the Dump Scow will shift over to the east side of the channel to dig around the timber piles. Hours of operation are 12 hours a day, 6 days a week, Monday through Saturday. All boaters should use the western channel and use extreme caution around all areas of the work.
