

CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

WHAT: Temporary Parking Restriction for Milling and Paving
WHERE: W. 18th Street between W. 19th Street and Hackensack Plank Road
WHEN: Anticipated 10/20/25 – 10/21/25 7:00 am to 3:30 pm

As part of ongoing roadway improvements, milling and paving work will take place on W. 18th Street. This work is expected to begin on or about October 20, 2025, and last approximately one to two days.

What to Expect:

- **Roadway:** W. 18th Street between W. 19th and Hackensack Plank Rd will remain open during the operation with a temporary parking restriction in place.
- **Milling and Paving:** Vehicles are encouraged to avoid the milled section of road where possible. Paving will be limited to an 18" section adjacent to the South Curb Line.
- **Driveway Access:** Residents will continue to have access to their driveways with flagging assistance where needed. The only exception will be for short periods when machinery is actively working directly in front of the property where a resident may be held momentary until the machine passes.
- **Parking:** Parking will be restricted on W. 18th Street and will not be available the evening preceding the work until paving and striping are complete. There will be signage, barrels and caution tape delineating the restricted area. SLD is committed to opening the road immediately following completion.

General Project Overview – The Palisades Tunnel Project will use tunnel boring machines (TBMs) to excavate two parallel tunnels—measuring approximately 5,100 feet long with an inside diameter of 25 feet—through the rock formations of the Palisades. The project also involves building the new Hudson County Shaft, which will be used to remove the TBMs when digging is complete. The project contractor is Schiavone Dragados Lane Joint Venture (SLDJV).

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
