

## CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

- WHAT:** Rock chopping progress and Sunday construction activities
- WHERE:** Hudson Yards Concrete Casing – Section 3 (HYCC-3) Project site, 11<sup>th</sup> Avenue and W. 30<sup>th</sup> Street
- WHEN:** Wednesday, November 12<sup>th</sup>, 2025; Sundays beginning as early as November 16<sup>th</sup>, 2025

As of Wednesday, November 12<sup>th</sup>, the vast majority of rock chopping and excavation activities at the Hudson Yards Concrete Casing-Section 3 (HYCC-3) Project site have been completed. To date, 29,900 cubic yards of rock have been removed out of a total 30,000 cubic yards.

Intermittent rock chopping may still occur in short bursts of about one hour to remove small sections of remaining material. That work will take place during daytime hours.

Beginning as early as Sunday, November 16<sup>th</sup>, the HYCC-3 contractor may also perform occasional work on Sundays during daylight hours. Potential activities include:

- Formwork installation
- Rock dowel drilling and installation on the eastern side of the project (nearest 11th Avenue)
- Preparation and pouring of concrete for tunnel walls
- Installation of waterproofing
- Preparation and installation of rebar

These activities are expected to generate noise levels similar to, or less than, those experienced prior to the start of rock chopping this spring.
