

CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

- WHAT:** Concrete pour
- WHERE:** The vicinity of 11th Avenue and W. 30th Street
- WHEN:** **REVISED Thursday, February 19, 2026** from 3:00 AM to 3:00 PM

As a result of pending weather conditions, the continuous concrete pour to build the Hudson Yards Concrete Casing-Section 3 (HYCC-3) Project is now scheduled to take place on **Thursday, February 19**, from 3:00 AM to 3:00 PM. This date and time is subject to change based on weather conditions.

This work is not expected to create excessive noise. However, trucks will be operating throughout the duration of the pour.

Trucks will stage along 11th Avenue and utilize part of 30th Street to cycle through the project site, deliver the concrete load and then exit onto 12th Avenue, per the diagram below. W. 30th Street may be closed between 11th and 12th Avenues during these activities.
