

CONSTRUCTION RESUMES

As a result of the restoration of outstanding federal funding reimbursements, beginning the week of February 23, construction is resuming at all Hudson Tunnel Project construction sites in New York and New Jersey. The Gateway Development Commission (GDC) expects that the nearly 1,000 jobs that were impacted by the construction pause will be restored.



Background

Federal funding for the Hudson Tunnel Project paused in October 2025. For four months, GDC utilized available funding sources and credit to keep the project moving forward as planned. Once GDC had drawn down nearly all available sources and credit, the project was forced to suspend construction on February 6, 2026.

On February 18, GDC announced the Project received all past-due federal disbursements and immediately moved to resume construction. Certain critical long-term activities, including procurements, will remain on hold.

GDC continues to pursue all avenues to secure access to all the federal funds committed to the Hudson Tunnel Project.
