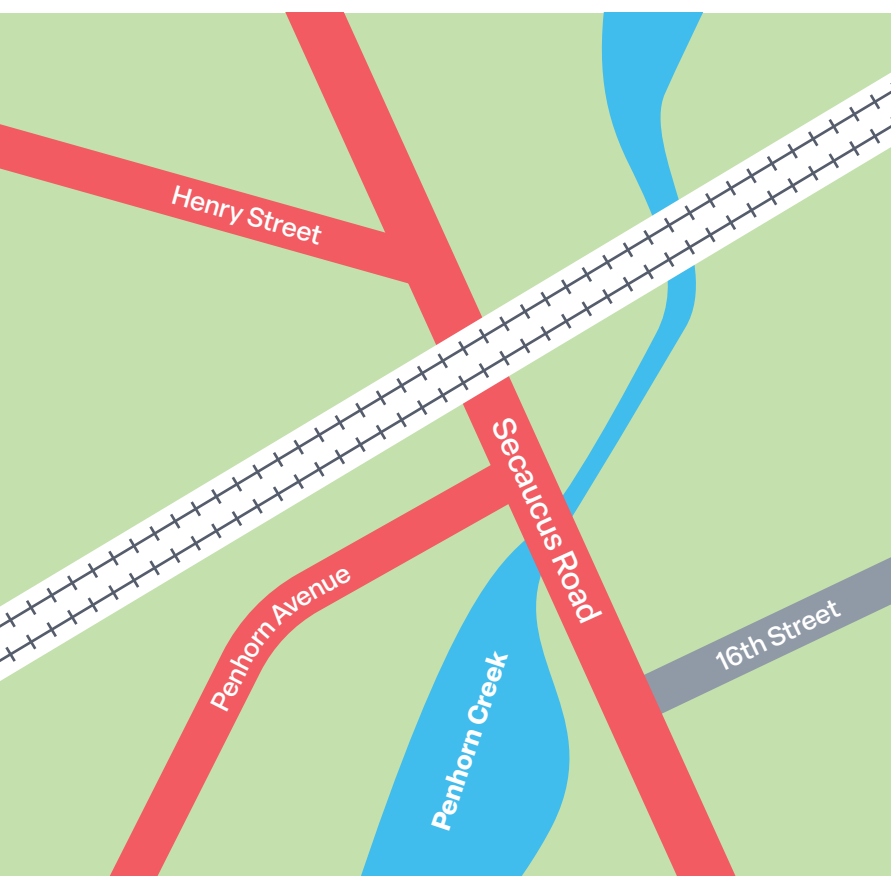


NJ Surface Alignment Update

TEST PIT WORK ON SECAUCUS ROAD

Construction crews are anticipated to begin test pit work along Secaucus Road, Penhorn Avenue, and Henry Street on **Monday, September 14**. The work will allow the project team to physically locate and document existing under ground utilities within the project limits in advance of future construction activities. Test pit work is expected to take approximately 15 to 20 working days depending on weather, field conditions, and other unforeseen circumstances.



Test Pit Work

Crews will excavate a series of test pits at select locations along Secaucus Road, Penhorn Ave., and Henry Street to locate and document existing underground utilities.

Test pits will be excavated using soft digging methods, including vacuum excavation and hand digging. Once a utility is located and exposed, crews will document its location and existing conditions. Each test pit will then be backfilled and the roadway pavement patched.

Traffic Impacts

Test pit work will be performed under temporary daily lane closures between **9:00am and 4:00pm**. Only one lane will be closed at a time, and flaggers will be used to safely maintain traffic through the work area.

Lane closures will begin on Penhorn Avenue before progressing to the southbound lanes of Secaucus Road and then the northbound lanes. Temporary traffic control measures will be removed at the end of each workday.
